- Flow of the course attendance;  
STEP1 Please access URL or QR code below and fill out the application form.  
Enter your name, address, desired course number, etc. in the form.  
STEP2 You will receive an application acceptance email.  
Once your application has been confirmed, we will send you an application acceptance email.  
※At this point, the course availability has not been fixed yet.  
STEP3 You will receive an application result email.  
After the applications have been processed, we will send you an application result mail.  
STEP4 If the result is “受講可能(Available)”, you can attend the course.  
If the result is “受講不可(Unavailable)”, please wait for cancellations or apply for other courses.  
※It may take longer for us respond because we don't use automatic reply service.
- Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The application deadline is 3 days before the course date, except for No.4 and 9. ※Ex. Course date: August 4 → Deadline: August 1
- In principle, each child can apply for up to **two courses**.  
\*If you apply for three or more courses, your third choice and above will be placed on a waiting list. We will let you know if the capacity has not been reached after the deadline.
- If the course capacity is already reached, you will be placed on a waiting list for cancellations.
- Please pay the material fee without any change at the location of the course you attend.

## Program ①

### 「Cooking the fish you caught deliciously」 & 「Takeda Quest-Rally」

【DATE】 July 31 (Wed.) 8:30-16:30 [Application Deadline] July 19 (Fri.) 1:00 p.m.

【FEE】 Child: 2,700 yen (2,000 yen for catching fish & Quest-Rally plus 700 yen for lunch) Guardian: 700 yen (for lunch)

\* Each child is limited to catching one fish. If you would like more, it will cost an extra 500 yen for each additional fish. Also, the fish-catching experience is for children only, so if guardians want to eat fish too, they can purchase extra fish for their children to catch.

\*For the Takeda Quest Rally, there is no experience fee for guardians who accompany their children. We ask all guardians to cooperate in ensuring the safety of their children.

### 「Making sand art candle」 & 「Searching for aquatic creatures and playing in the river」

【DATE】 August 21 (Wed.) 8:30-16:30 Application deadline: August 16 (Fri.) 1:00 pm

【FEE】 Child: 3,500 yen (2,800 yen for candle making & the river play plus 700 yen for lunch) Guardian: 1,500 yen  
(800 yen for the river play, 700 yen for lunch)

\*If guardians want to participate in candle making, it will cost 2,000 yen per person.

\*If the guardian does not participate in the river play, the participation fee of 800 yen will be waived.

【Destination】 Sakai City Takeda Nosanson Koryu Center "ChikuChiku-BonBon"

\*The program will proceed even if it rains lightly (with some changes to the program)

\*The program will be canceled if it is too stormy.

【Meeting place】 Echizen City Hall (1-13-7 Fuchu) or Ai Park Imadate (9-1-9 Awatabe-cho)

【Subject】 All grades of elementary school students

## Clothes and Belongings

### Cooking the fish you caught deliciously

- ① clothes you don't mind getting dirty ② towel ③ a change of clothes ④ sun protection (if you have) ⑤ drinks

### Takeda Quest-Rally

- ① light long sleeve clothes ② long pants ③ socks (to prevent insect bites)  
④ cap or hat (for sun protection) ⑤ bug spray (if necessary) ⑥ sunscreen (if necessary)  
⑦ drinks (bring extra to prevent heatstroke)



### Searching for aquatic creatures in the water and playing in the river

- ① clothes that can get wet (a long-sleeve rash guard, etc.)  
② shoes that cover the heels and can get wet, such as water shoes, etc. (Please refrain from wearing sandals or crocs as they may cause you to fall down.)  
③ goggles (if you have) ④ bath towel ⑤ a change of clothes ⑥ sunscreen (if necessary)  
⑦ drinks (bring extra to prevent heatstroke)

## Notes

- 1 If you have any regular medication, please bring it with you. (We will prepare a basic first aid kit.)
- 2 If you have food allergies, please tell the center staff when you apply.
- 3 Please kindly note that the program content and schedule may change depending on the weather. Please follow the instructions of the instructor and staff during the program.
