Types of garbage (examples)

Burnable Garbage

food scraps
 paper waste
 clothing and cloth
 plant matter
 Video tapes/
 cassette tapes

● **food scraps** ● **event garbage** ● **others**

bento, takoyaki, yakisoba containers, etc.
 clothing and cloth
 smaller than 5 cm in width and shorter than 50 cm in length
 pruning
 disposable diapers
 weeds

※Plastic containers, packaging, and bottles that are soiled and difficult to clean should be disposed of as **burnable garbage**.

- Drain food scraps thoroughly.
- Cut wood chips, pruning scraps, etc. into **5 cm square pieces, 50 cm or less in length**, and tie them together into bundles with string or place them in burnable garbage bags for disposal. ※ Burning household trash in fields is prohibited by law.
- Cut clothing down to 1 meter in length and remove any metal parts.
- Video tape cases /cassette tape cases → **Non-burnable garbage**
- Please help with recycling used paper products.

Plastic Containers and Packaging

● Plastic Containers and Packaging marked as  ○ Rinse them in water before throwing them out.

● Others

- Cushioning material (Styrofoam)
- Netting (for fruits, vegetables, etc.)
- Trays (food trays)
- Plastic bags

○ If they are difficult to clean, then dispose of them as "Burnable Garbage".

○ Do not put garbage that has been packed in bags into "Plastic Containers and Packaging" bags. (If the bags are doubled, the contents cannot be checked.)

⚠ **Never put the following in "Plastic Containers and Packaging" bags: (for manual sorting)**

- × Hazardous materials (razors, scissors, broken glass, etc.)
- × Plastic products (PP bands, toys, buckets, etc.) → **Non-burnable Garbage**
- × Medical waste (IV packages, tubes, etc.) → **Burnable Garbage**
- × PET bottles removed caps and labels → Use designated light blue basket for "PET bottles" instead

Designated bag (pink)

Cans
 aluminum or steel



Up to half the size of an 18 liter drum

Cans/Bottles (food or drink containers)

- Remove the caps and **clean off any dirt**.
- Plastic lids and caps → **Plastic Containers and Packaging**
- Metal lids and caps → **Non-burnable Garbage**
- Broken bottles may be placed in the colored baskets.

⚠ **Never put the following in recyclables**
 Cans and bottles other than food and drink products (cosmetics, ceramics, etc.) → **Non-burnable Garbage**

○ Remove the cap and label, and rinse the bottle before throwing it out.

● Labels/Caps → **Plastic Containers and Packaging**

※If it is impossible to clean, dispose of it as "Burnable Garbage".

Spray cans
 Gas canisters

● **Spray cans**  Use up the entire contents of the can, then vent the excess gas. Use the cap to vent the gas.

● **Gas canisters**  There is no gas venting cap. Use the gas canister until it is empty.

⚠ **Never dispose of them as "Non-burnable Garbage". They are a fire hazard for garbage trucks.**

- Even if they are broken, dispose of fluorescent bulbs as hazardous waste.
- Use lighters up entirely before throwing them out.
- If rechargeable batteries are not removable, throw them out with the unit.
- Put mercury thermometers and sphygmomanometers in a plastic bag.

● **Batteries**  Button batteries must be insulated before they are disposed of.

● **Fluorescent bulbs**  under 1.6 meters

● **Mercury vapor bulbs**

● **Mercury thermometers**

● **Lighters/matches**

● **Electronic cigarettes**

Oversize garbage

Household furniture, bedding, etc. less than 1.8 meters in length, 40 kg in weigh, and 1 cubic meter in size

See the box at the bottom right for information on direct delivery.

● **Eligible items**

- Wooden furniture and appliances (tables, doors, kotatsu, etc.)
- Bedding/tatami/carpets/etc.
- Plastic products, ceramics, leather, etc. too large for designated bags.

● **Ineligible items**

- × Tires, car batteries, box springs, wire, weight stones, and concrete pole supports must be brought directly to Dai-Ni(2) Seiso Center.
- × The Items Which Cannot Be Processed below
- × Please help with bringing metal and electrical items to the stockyard stated below.

Metal goods and electronics

● **metal goods** ● **electronics** If batteries are mixed in, there is a risk of fire.

- Remove batteries, rechargeable batteries, fluorescent lamps, kerosene, etc. in advance.
- Remove all your personal information.
- The Items Which Cannot Be Processed below cannot be collected.
- Wooden (kotatsu, etc.) and cloth (electric carpets, etc.) electrical items cannot be collected.

You can also use the small appliances collection box.

Locations: community centers, Hearts Takefu (Shibahara 4-chome), City Hall, Aipark Imadate, Chuo Library, Imadate Library

Hours: facility business hours

Eligible Items: small home appliances (digital cameras, hairdryers, etc. that use electricity or batteries) that will fit in the collection box (15 cm x 25 cm)

※remove the batteries.

From April 2024

Bring to the following location:

- Location: Stockyard (Kitago 1-chome 3-20)
- Hours: 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (closed Wednesdays and Thursdays)
- Disposal fee: Free
- Accepted garbage: Metals, electrical goods, bicycles, paper

- Wrap glass, ceramics, knives, etc. in newspaper and label them as "Kikenbutsu (dangerous goods)"
- Cut all strings and netting down to within 50 cm.
- Consult the hospital or distributor for disposal of injection needles and other items.
- CD cases and DVD cases → "Non-burnable Garbage"

⚠ To avoid the risk of fires, remove batteries, rechargeable batteries, etc. and dispose of them as hazardous waste.

Items Which Cannot Be Processed
 (consult a shop or a specialized collection disposal company)

● **Recyclable consumer electronics**

- air conditioners
- refrigerators
- freezers
- televisions
- washing machines
- dryers

Roof tiles, bricks/blocks, concrete, pesticides, explosives, car parts, kerosene, etc. Paint, syringes, agricultural machinery, soil/stones, fire extinguishers, pianos, construction waste, engines, industrial waste, etc.

● **Recycle paper products**

Use your neighborhood association's group collection service, or use the storefront collection services at supermarkets, etc.

● **Paper products**

Separate paper into three categories: cardboard, newspapers, and magazines/miscellaneous.

Drop off at the cleaning center

- Location: Eco-Clean Center Nan-etsu (Ueno 85-39, Minamiechizen-cho / ☎47-2553) ※ Bedding/tatami/carpets can be brought directly to Eco-Clean Center Nan-etsu.
- Hours: Weekdays (Mon-Fri), 8:30-16:30
- Processing fee: 60 yen/10 kg
- Accepted waste: Burnable Garbage
- Location: Dai-Ni(2) Seiso Center (Kotogahara-cho 86-28 / ☎28-1370)
- Hours: Weekdays (Mon-Fri) and the 2nd Sunday of the month, 8:30-16:30 Reservations required by phone at least 2 days in advance.
- Processing fee: 60 yen/10 kg (additional fees charged for tires, batteries, and box springs)
- Accepted waste: Recyclable waste, Plastic Containers and Packaging, Non-burnable Garbage, Oversize Garbage

Commercial waste: general waste generated from business activities is not accepted at garbage stations or collection sites. Separate them and bring them in directly or contact a licensed contractor to collect them.
