*Plastic containers, packaging, and bottles that are soiled and difficult to clean should be disposed of as burnable garbage.

Drain food scraps thoroughly.

Cut wood chips, pruning scraps, etc. into 5 cm es, 50 cm or less in length, and tie them together into bundles with string or place them in burnable garbage bags for disposal. Burning household trash in fields is prohibited by law

Cut clothing down to 1 meter in length and remove any metal parts.




